




Typhoon Mawar started as a tropical depression southwest of Chuuk Island

An Example (Contract Clause)

"Vendor" shall enter into and shall maintain in effect with appropriate parties one or more agreements making reasonable provision of emergency use of electronic data processing equipment to the extent appropriate equipment is available. In the event of equipment failures, Vendor shall, at no additional expense to the Client, take reasonable steps to minimize service interruptions but shall have no liability with respect thereto.
